Subj: Asia-Pacific Chapter Report

1. Status of the Chapter

- a. Membership - Currently there are 27 members of the chapter. Our targeted membership drive begins June 1, 2014.
- b. Finances - According to our records, we have a minimum of \$800 available for chapter use. All of our funds are held by national AIG.
- c. Training Held in 2014 - The chapter hosted a luncheon training event at the Hale Ikena, Fort Shafter, Hawaii on March 31, 2014 on Investment Fraud in Hawaii. Trainers were Amy Hudson, senior enforcement attorney and Leolyn Anderson, supervising investigator, both with Hawaii's Department of Commerce and Consumer Affairs. Attendees earned 1 CPE at the completion of the training.
- d. Planned Training for 2014 - We have scheduled a one-day training symposium on October 1, 2014. Tom Caufield has agreed to provide training on procurement fraud and we expect to award 8 CPEs for full attendance.

2. Chapter Support from National

- a. Chapter Webpage on the AIG Website - No issues at this time.
- b. Membership Payments - Received membership report from AIG executive director dated May 5, 2014. No issues at this time.
- c. CPE Credits for Training - Normally national AIG provides CPE certificates to attendees within 30 days of chapter training. We have not yet received CPE certificates for our March 31, 2014 training and are working with the executive director to resolve.

d. Finances - Chapter president or members submit vouchers to the national AIG treasurer for reimbursement and are usually reimbursed within 30 days for documented chapter expenses. Since training event expenses usually exceed \$500, this method has become burdensome and we seek a better alternative to accessing chapter funds.

3. Additional Information

a. Grants - Our chapter will seek a \$2000 grant for our fall 2014 training symposium which will be used to fund the venue and Tom Caufield's travel expenses.

b. Other Meetings Held - The executive committee of the chapter met on February 13, 2014. The chapter's board of directors met March 31, 2014 in conjunction with the luncheon training event. And the executive committee of the chapter is scheduled to meet May 29, 2014.
