During a 24-year U.S. Air Force career, Bob served as a Special Agent with the Air Force Office of Special Investigations (OSI). Bob focused on conducting and leading Department of Defense procurement fraud and felony-level crimes against persons investigations. Bob completed his Air Force career as the Air Force OSI Detachment Commander at Eglin Air Force Base, Florida, the world's largest Air Force Base.

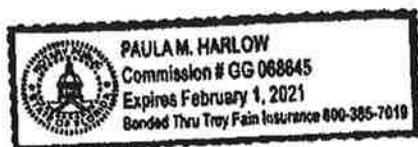
Bob began his career with the State of Florida in 1997 as the Director of Investigations for the Florida Department of Transportation's Office of Inspector General. He and his section investigated internal and external crimes and misconducts impacting the Department with a focus on contract crimes resulting in a financial loss to the Department.

In 2007, Florida's Chief Financial Officer selected Bob as the Inspector General for the Florida Department of Financial Services where he led professional audits, consulting services and internal investigations.

In March 2011, Bob returned to the Florida Department of Transportation as Inspector General. He and the OIG team work to enhance accountability, efficiency, and transparency within the Department of Transportation, an executive branch agency with a \$10.6B annual budget, by conducting performance, contract, and intermodal audits as well as contract fraud and employee misconduct investigations.

Bob is currently serving as the First Vice President of the Association of Inspectors General, Chairman of the Association's Professional Certification Board and President of the Association's Florida Chapter. Bob has received the Certified Inspector General and Certified Inspector General Investigator designations from the Association. Bob is a graduate of The Florida State University with an honors degree in Criminology.
