

Biographical Sketch of David T. Harper, Nominee for AIG Board of Directors

David T. Harper was appointed as the Inspector General for the City of Albuquerque in April 2016 by the City Council, where he leads an independent office and has oversight responsibility for the Mayor and his administration, the City Council and Council Services, as well as various commissions, boards and recipients of City funds to include contractors.

Prior to his current position, David served on active duty with the United States Air Force (USAF) beginning in 1976 with assignments in North Dakota and West Berlin, then transferred to the USAF Reserves in 1985 and had assignments in Sacramento, CA and New Jersey. He began his civil service career in 1988, as a Special Agent for Air Force Office of Special Investigations, where he had assignments in New York City, Los Angeles, Boston and the Washington, DC, area. In his last seven years he was the Chief, Economic Crime Desk, and in that capacity he provided oversight and support to more than 200 locations worldwide and more than 500 fraud investigations. Prior to that assignment, he was the Special Agent-in-Charge of the New England area office, which also had oversight of offices in New York. Thirty of his 35 years with OSI were spent in the economic crime area, with specific focus on fraud and corruption, to include procurement fraud. During his federal career, he was either directly or indirectly involved in civil and criminal fraud investigations resulting in the collective recovery of more than \$1 billion dollars.

While in Washington, DC, David served on the Steering Committee and training sub-committee for the Department of Defense Procurement Fraud Working Group, where he helped plan and organize the annual Procurement Fraud Training Conferences, from 2008 to 2016. He also provided presentations on various topics at the conferences and coordinated guest speakers on a wide range of topics within fraud and corruption areas.

David was an instructor in the Criminal Justice program for the University of Phoenix for more than 14 years, teaching in the “ground campus” in Los Angeles and later in the “on-line” format.

In addition to his membership in the Association of Inspectors General, he is also a member of the Association of Certified Fraud Examiners (ACFE) and the International Association of Financial Crime Investigators. He serves on the ACFE Advisory Council and is a Board Member of the ACFE New Mexico Chapter. David has a Master’s in Public Administration and a Bachelor in Criminal Justice degree from Sacramento State, where he graduated with Honors. He has the following certifications: Certified Inspector General, Certified Fraud Examiner and Certified Financial Crime Investigator. David is the recipient of the Air Force Outstanding Civilian Career Service Award and the Air Force General Counsel’s Award.
