Prior to entering the community of Inspectors General, David McClintock served over 20 years in various roles of law enforcement and nearly 10 years as a lawyer in both government and private practice. In February of 2010, he was appointed as the Inspector General of Baltimore City. There, Mr. McClintock instituted innovative programs such as the "Self Reporting Program" and "Rewards Program." He also implemented performance metrics, tracked funds, recovered funds, and provided OIG based training to all new City employees and supervisors.


In March of 2013, Mr. McClintock was appointed by the newly created Jefferson Parish Ethics and Compliance Commission as the inaugural Inspector General of Jefferson Parish. In just under twenty months from inception, the JPOIG evolved from a concept to a fully operational office. The JPOIG is now moving into its 4<sup>th</sup> full year of operation and looking forward to its first AIG peer review.
