In July 2018, Melinda Miguel was appointed as the Inspector General for the U.S. Government Publishing Office in Washington, D.C. She served a Governor Rick Scott's and former Governor Charlie Crist's appointee as the Chief Inspector General for the Executive Office of the Governor where she had responsibility for working with Inspectors General in the State of Florida to coordinate accountability, integrity and efficiency in state government. Ms. Miguel served in this role from January 2007 to November 2010 and February 2011 to April 2017.

Ms. Miguel has over 28 years of public service and also served as the Inspector General for the following state government agencies:

Florida Attorney General's Office
Florida Department of Elder Affairs

She has served as Deputy IG for the Architect of the Capitol in Washington, D.C.; Bureau Chief of Auditing and Tax Collection for the Division of Alcoholic Beverages and Tobacco, Department of Business and Professional Regulation, State of Florida, and Supervisory Investigator and Auditor in the Office of Inspector General for the Florida Lottery in Tallahassee, Florida.

For seven years, Ms. Miguel served on the Audit Committee for the SBA including two terms as the Chair to assist the Florida Trustees (The Governor, the State's elected CFO, and the Attorney General) with oversight of Florida's investments and governance of the SBA, including the Florida Retirement System Pension Plan, which is the fourth largest public retirement plan in the United States.

Ms. Miguel is the Senior Vice-president At-Large for the National Executive Committee and the past Regional Vice President for the Gulf Coast Region of the Association of Government Accountants (AGA). Ms. Miguel is the Director-at-Large and Education Committee Chair for the Tallahassee Chapter of the AGA. She also served on the AGA's National Partnership Steering Committee and the Collaborative Forum with the Office of Management and Budget, Executive Office of the President. She is also an Advisor to the International Association of Financial Crimes Investigators including a co-chair of the Elder Fraud Awareness Committee.

Ms. Miguel is the immediate past National President of the Association of Inspectors General (AIG), a current member of the national Executive Committee, co-chair of the Legislative Issues Committee, and member of the Professional Standards Committee. She is on the Board of the Florida Chapter of the AIG; the past Chair of the Florida Audit Forum; and the past President of the Tallahassee Chapter of the Institute for Internal Auditors. She is also the President of the Federal Bureau of Investigations Citizens Academy Alumni Association, Tallahassee Chapter.

Ms. Miguel received a Bachelor of Science Degree in Economics and a Graduate Certificate in Florida Local Government Administration from Florida State University. She is a Certified Inspector General, Certified Financial Services Auditor, Certified Business Manager, Certified Internal Controls Auditor, Certified Cyber Crimes Investigator, Certified Construction Auditor, Certified Florida Government Manager, and Certified Project Management Professional. She has also held a certification in the past as a Certified Government Financial Manager and Certified Fraud Examiner.
