

BARRY KLUGER

In February 2007, Barry Kluger was appointed by the Governor of the State of New York to serve as the Inspector General of the New York Metropolitan Transportation Authority. Shortly after his appointment, Mr. Kluger joined the Association of Inspectors General. He has served on many committees, including Treasury/ Finance and Ethics, and been a speaker/lecturer at Association conferences.

In 2009, Mr. Kluger was elected to the Board of the Association, and in 2010 was elected the Association's Second Vice President. He presently serves in that capacity.

In fulfilling his responsibilities as Second Vice President Mr. Kluger has paid particular attention to the work of the Association's operations and administrative services. The executive director of the Association, as well as the Association's staff, are headquartered at John Jay College of Criminal Justice in New York. The proximity of Mr. Kluger's office to John Jay College affords him the opportunity to meet regularly and work closely with the Association's Executive Director. Specifically, Mr. Kluger works with the Treasurer of the Association and the Finance Committee in reviewing the Association's budget, finances, and program initiatives, both to ensure the fiscal stability of the Association and provide oversight of services performed by the executive director and the Association's staff. Further, Mr. Kluger, in his capacity as 2nd VP, coordinates and works closely with both the Integrity/Ethics and Constitution/By-Laws committees.

Most recently, Mr. Kluger served as Co-Chair of the Search Committee for a new Executive Director, which led to the selection and hiring of Ron Calvosa for that position.

By way of background, until his appointment as Inspector General, Mr. Kluger served in the Office of the Bronx County District Attorney, including 18 years as its Chief Assistant District Attorney. Throughout his tenure with the Bronx District Attorney, Mr. Kluger also served as the chief liaison to the offices of district attorneys, United States Attorneys, Inspectors General in New York City, and to other law enforcement agencies.

As Metropolitan Transportation Authority Inspector General Mr. Kluger has broad statutory functions, powers, and duties, including receiving and investigating criminal complaints; initiating reviews of the operations of the MTA to identify areas in which performance might be improved; and issuing reports to the Governor and Legislature containing his findings and recommendations. The Inspector General also serves as a member of the New York State Public Transportation Safety Board.
