Biography

I served as the Executive Director of AIG from 2011 to April 2018. During my tenure, the Association's membership increased from approximately 500 to nearly 2,000. As Executive Director, I oversaw the day-to-day operations of the organization, which included the administration of 6 national conferences and 14 IG Institutes. I also served as an IG Institute Instructor.


At the same time as serving as the Association's Executive Director, I was also a member of the faculty at John Jay College of Criminal Justice in the Department of Public Management. I taught graduate level courses in government ethics, law, and government inspection and oversight in the Masters of Public Administration Inspection and Oversight program. My retirement from the College becomes fully effective at the end of 2018.

From 1998 to 2010, I served as the Inspector General for the City of Yonkers, NY. As the City's first IG, I established the office. After leaving Yonkers government, I supervised investigations into conspiracies involving claims for compensation for damages incurred as a result of the BP/Deepwater Horizon offshore oil well explosion and oil spill in the Gulf of Mexico.

Prior to becoming an IG, I was a municipal trial attorney for the City of New York.

I received a law degree from American University, Washington College of Law in 1986. I earned my Inspector General Certification from the Association in 2002.

I am currently writing a book on inspectors general.
