

Call for 2020 AIG Training Conference Proposals

If you would like to be considered as a speaker/presenter or to moderate a panel discussion, we are soliciting proposals.

PROPOSAL FORMAT:

- **TITLE**
- **PRESENTER/MODERATOR**
- **OBJECTIVE** (Max 50 words): *What are the overarching outcomes you hope to achieve from your proposal/presentation/panel?*
- **ABSTRACT** (Max 100 words) *Important takeaways.*
- **SPEAKER DIVERSITY** (Max 50 words): *How will your presentation/panel contribute to the AIG's commitment to creating and supporting diverse and inclusive training conferences. See commitment statement below.*
- **PRESENTATION DESCRIPTION** (Max 500 words):
 1. *Further details to include the relevance or value to the IG community.*
 2. *If a panel, who would the panel consist?*

Include your name, title, organization, phone number, and email address.

Presenters will generally have 60 minutes to give an introduction, give their presentation, do closing remarks, and take questions.

Under no circumstances should a presentation or panel be used for direct promotion of a speaker's product, service, or other self-interest. Commercial solicitation is prohibited at all presentations. If the essential purpose of a proposal is to promote books, materials, or services for sale, it will not be accepted.

SUBMISSION DEADLINE

The submission deadline is **March 4, 2020**. No proposals will be accepted after this date. Notification of acceptance will be provided in April 2020. Scheduling information will be sent to all participants during the summer.
