

David McClintock, Jefferson Parish Inspector General

Prior to entering the community of Inspectors General, David McClintock served over 20 years in various roles of law enforcement and nearly 10 years as a lawyer in both government and private practice. In February of 2010, he was appointed as the Inspector General of Baltimore City. During his three years with Baltimore Mr. McClintock instituted a "Self Reporting Program" and "Rewards Program", as well as, implementing performance metrics and a training program on the OIG for all new City employees and supervisors.

In March of 2013, Mr. McClintock was appointed as the inaugural Inspector General for Jefferson Parish Louisiana. In just under twenty months from inception, the JPOIG evolved from a concept to a fully operational office. Mr. McClintock was appointed to a second term in 2018 and credits the support and information sharing within the AIG community as being vital to the office's success. Mr. McClintock currently serves the AIG Board's Executive Committee and as the Chair of the Government Relations and Outreach Committee.

His perspective on the AIG comes exclusively from the state and municipal OIG community. He states, "While the number of offices continues to increase, there remains great diversity in the structure on which many are founded upon, and in the expectations of their governing authorities. The AIG has become a major voice in the community, a trusted resource to the media, and an invaluable resource to the many Inspectors General who address difficult, interesting and sometimes unique obstacles. My own experience tells me that this organization has made positive impacts on the community through outreach, training and peer review. I hope to see continued development in these areas. If permitted to continuing to serve the AIG as a member of the Board of Directors, I look forward to giving back to the community that I value greatly and make an added positive impact going forward."
