


Lora L. Manon is currently the Secretary for the Association of Inspectors General. Ms. Manon has held this position since 2009 when she began her term as a member of the Association's Board of Directors. In addition to her service as a member of Board, she is a member of the Executive Committee. In 2010, Lora became a Certified Inspector General™ after completing the CIG Institute™. She is currently employed as an Assistant Prosecuting Attorney for Hancock County, Ohio, working in the adult felony division.

Lora is has devoted her career of more than 30 years as an attorney to public service. She is a former Chief Legal Counsel for the Office of the Ohio Inspector General, where she served from 2005 – 2011. In that position, she drafted legislation that expanded the Office's statutory authority, creating dedicated deputy inspectors general for various state agencies. She prepared ethics training for both in-house and interagency presentation. While working in the Ohio Inspector General's Office, Lora participated in the largest multi-agency task force investigation of corruption, waste, fraud and abuse in Ohio's history. She received an award for her efforts in that case from the Ohio Prosecuting Attorney's Association for being a part of the Outstanding Prosecution Team. More recently, she held the positions of Associate Legal Counsel and Chief Ethics Officer for the Ohio Department of Public Safety, and Assistant Prosecuting Attorney for Fairfield County, where she was the Chief of the Criminal Division.


In addition, Lora has served as Assistant Law Director for the Cities of Toledo and Defiance, Ohio, and as an Assistant Prosecutor in Hardin County, Ohio. In 1996, she was elected Hardin County Prosecuting Attorney, the first woman to hold that office and one of the first six women to hold the position of the elected county prosecutor in the state of Ohio.

Lora is committed to ensuring integrity in government at all levels. Similarly, she supports the goals and mission of the Association, and will continue to work to see that the organization operates effectively and efficiently.

Ms. Manon's other community involvement includes membership in the Hancock County Bar Association, the Ohio State Bar Association, BPW/Ohio (State President 1997-1998, and current president of the Retirement Living Foundation), membership at the First Presbyterian Church, Bryan, Ohio, (ordained Elder), member of the Bryan City Band and Worthington Civic Band, and she has had the privilege of sounding "Taps" at the Gettysburg National Cemetery in 2019.. Lora is presently the temporary pastor at the Tontogany Presbyterian Church, Tontogany, Ohio.
