Carol “Jodie” Breece began with the Broward Office of the Inspector General in 2012. Her agency serves the 1.9 million residents of the second most populous county in Florida, watching over the county’s and its 31 municipalities’ \$10 billion in budgets. The Broward OIG investigates and reports misconduct and gross mismanagement, with responsibility encompassing more than 170 elected officials, 28,000 employees, and 15,000 registered providers. As General Counsel, Jodie helps formulate and direct agency policy and procedures; ensures agency compliance with applicable law; serves as the agency’s legal representative; directs agency litigation; oversees ethics, public records, open meetings, and elections investigations; and supervises the legal staff. She also teaches public service ethics and professionalism to graduate students in public administration as an Adjunct Professor at Florida International University, doing so since 2015.

Jodie was a state prosecutor for 17 years, including nine years as the Chief Assistant Statewide Prosecutor for Miami, and had a law practice in civil and criminal white-collar defense and witness representation in state and federal court. Her cases included all manner of fraud, conspiracy, money laundering, narcotics trafficking, public corruption, racketeering (RICO), and securities violations. In commercial litigation, she facilitated forensic accounting and consulting services to counsel and courts, including forensic analysis, reporting, and testimony, and she directed receiverships and assignments for the benefit of creditors.

She obtained her J.D. from The Catholic University of America in Washington, D.C. and her B.A. in Criminal Justice from the University of Maryland at College Park. Jodie is admitted to practice law in Florida state courts, the U.S. District Court for the Southern District of Florida, the U.S. Fourth Circuit Court of Appeals, the U.S. Eleventh Circuit Court of Appeals, and the U.S. Supreme Court. She has been Board Certified in Criminal Trial Law by The Florida Bar since 1999, AV Rated by Martindale-Hubbell since 1999, a Certified Fraud Examiner since 2010, and a Certified Inspector General since 2016.

Jodie has 25 years of experience serving on boards and committees of The Florida Bar, voluntary bar associations, and other local community and professional organizations. Her personal interests include reading, travel, vegetarian cooking, fitness training, and her husband Jack.
