Dr. Ronald (Ron) Henson joined the District of Columbia Office of the Inspector General in November 2016 and serves as the Deputy Assistant Inspector General for Inspections and Evaluations (I&E). In this capacity, he directs and oversees inspectors' day-to-day operations and activities within the Inspections and Evaluations Unit. Dr. Henson's responsibilities include planning, coordinating, and executing I&E assessments and evaluation projects designed to promote economy, efficiency, and effectiveness in, and provide accountability for District of Columbia government agencies, programs, and resources.

Additionally, Dr. Henson directs, coaches, and mentors his staff on operational analysis and data collection methodologies on all assessment and evaluation projects by employing qualitative and quantitative methods that aggregate public sector data sources.

Prior to his service to the District of Columbia, Dr. Henson served as a U.S. Army Officer (Lieutenant Colonel), assigned to the Military District of Washington until retirement. His 26 years of distinguished service include serving as an Officer and Enlisted member in various leadership, organizational management, and operations management positions.

Dr. Henson also served in Afghanistan during Operation Enduring Freedom as the Operations and Training Officer within the 205th Corps Embedded Training Team, earning the Bronze Star Medal for planning and leading combat operations of U.S. military, Joint Coalition, and Afghan Army forces.

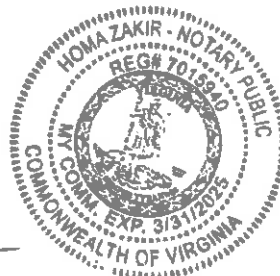
During the latter part of Dr. Henson's military career, he served as the Division Chief of Inspections and Analysis at the Inspector General's Office, National Guard Bureau, from 2011 through 2015. In that capacity, he led the development, execution, and completion of various compliance and organizational improvement assessments of Department of Defense programs, processes, and resources that supported over 350,000 service members.

Dr. Henson also serves as the Vice-Chair of Strategy for the U.S. Senate Productivity and Quality Award (SPQA) Program for Virginia and D.C. This non-profit helps large-scale organizations and small businesses implement systems approaches to improving their organization's performance through the Baldrige Excellence Framework.

Dr. Henson earned a Bachelor of Science in Business Administration from Alabama State University. He also holds a Master of Science in Quality Systems Management and Doctor of Business Administration degree from The National Graduate School of Quality Management.

Dr. Henson is married to the former Rosemary Lewis, Commander, U.S. Navy, who enjoys raising their daughter (Taylor). He enjoys playing golf, listening to jazz, and bike riding in his spare time.
