Dr. Glenda B. Arrington is the Inspector General for a Department of Defense Agency. She has an extensive professional portfolio spanning over 35 years in the public and private sector, academia, community outreach, and non-profit board leadership. As the Inspector General, she is charged with overseeing Inspectors General matters of waste, fraud, abuse, and mismanagement. She has served as the Inspector General for the Department of Defense and Department of Navy throughout Virginia, Maryland, and the District of Columbia.

Dr. Arrington is a Certified Inspector General and Certified Investigator with the Council of the Inspectors General on Integrity and Efficiency, the Association of Inspectors General, the Department of Defense Joint Inspectors General, and the Office of the Naval Inspector General. She is a Certified Fraud Examiner and Enterprise Risk Manager. She is also certified with the Federal Law Enforcement Center. Dr. Arrington developed the first-ever Compliance Inspection program for a Department of Defense agency. Dr. Arrington contributed to the development of the Association of Inspectors General Inspector/Evaluator Institute. She is a Peer Review Leader for the Association of Inspectors General at the federal, state and local levels. She developed the Navy Ethos Creed of Core Values for military, civilian and contractor employees.

Dr. Arrington's past positions include serving as the Inspector General for Naval District Washington, District of Columbia; the Deputy Inspector General, Strategic Systems Programs, Washington, D.C; and as the Director, Assessment and Evaluation, United States Fleet Forces, Norfolk, Virginia.

Dr. Arrington is a graduate of the Harvard Kennedy School of Government, the Office of Personnel Management Senior Executive Assessment Program, Northwestern University Kellogg Executive Education, Federal Executive Institute, and the Navy Corporate Business Naval Postgraduate School. Dr. Arrington received her doctoral degree in Organizational Leadership from Northcentral University.

Dr. Arrington is a Senior Executive Association, Board Member; Association of Inspectors General, Board Member; Federal Executive Institute Alumni Association, Board Member; and the Executive Administrator for the Carl Brashear Foundation.
