

## RICHARD DAVID HOLMGREN

David Holmgren most recently served as the Deputy Inspector General for Inspections and Evaluations (I&E) with the Texas Health and Human Services Commission Office of Inspector General. In that role, David conducted inspections of Texas Medicaid programs and directed oversight of the Women, Infants, and Children (WIC) vendor monitoring unit.

Mr. Holmgren previously served as a career member of the federal senior executive service as the Treasury Inspector General for Tax Administration (TIGTA)'s Deputy Inspector General for Inspections and Evaluations. He assumed that position in November 2008, where he was responsible for oversight of major Internal Revenue Service activities and programs. His evaluation of the IRS Tax Gap was recognized with an Award of Excellence in 2014 by the Council of the Inspectors General on Integrity and Efficiency (CIGIE).

After a distinguished military career, he was selected as the Deputy Director of Manpower Resources for the Chief of Naval Operations. In March 2003, Mr. Holmgren was selected as the Inspector General for the Office of Naval Intelligence and then was named as the first Inspector General for the Navy Installations Command. In March 2006, David was selected as the Deputy Inspector General of the Marine Corps where he directed oversight programs that included inspections, assessments, evaluations, investigations, and intelligence oversight.

Mr. Holmgren enlisted in the Air Force and earned his commission as a graduate of the Officer Training School. He spent the majority of his career conducting manpower and organizational effectiveness studies. In June 1995, he transferred from the Pentagon to the NATO headquarters in Naples, Italy. In 1998, he was asked by the Joint Chiefs of Staff to continue his service to NATO as the sole U.S. representative to the thirteen-nation Manpower Study Team in Brussels, Belgium. He retired from active duty in 2000.

Mr. Holmgren's military decorations include the Meritorious Service Medal with four oak leaf clusters plus other individual and unit awards. He was awarded the Department of the Navy Meritorious Civilian Service Award in 2003 and the Department of the Navy Superior Civilian Service Award in 2006.

Mr. Holmgren holds several degrees, including a Bachelor of Science degree in Business from Golden Gate University, a Master of Arts degree in International Relations from Creighton University, and was accepted as a doctoral student at George Mason University in Community College Education.

David has been a member of the Association of Inspectors General Board of Directors since 2016. He has been a Certified Inspector General since 2005. He is also a member of the Association of Certified Fraud Examiners.
