

## State Inspector General Michael C. Westfall

Michael C. Westfall was appointed State Inspector General of the Commonwealth of Virginia in April 2018. Mr. Westfall leads the Office of the State Inspector General, an organization comprised of 40 full-time staff with an annual budget of approximately \$6.5 million.

Mr. Westfall has more than 31 years of experience conducting audits and investigations at the federal, state and local levels. He previously served as acting state inspector general and deputy inspector general. Prior to joining the Office of the State Inspector General in January 2015, Mr. Westfall served as the chief audit executive for the Virginia State Police, where he oversaw the internal audit function. Prior to joining the Virginia State Police, he served as director and assistant director for the Chesterfield County Office of Internal Audit, where he oversaw internal audits and hotline investigations for over 20 years. He began his professional career as an auditor for the U.S. Department of the Interior – Office of Inspector General.

Mr. Westfall holds a master's degree in accountancy from Virginia Commonwealth University and is a Certified Inspector General, Certified Public Accountant and Certified Fraud Examiner. He is a member of the Association of Inspectors General, Institute of Internal Auditors, Association of Certified Fraud Examiners and Virginia Local Government Auditors Association.
