


Selvyn William Fletcher's bio for Association of Inspectors General Board (July 2022)

Will Fletcher was appointed Inspector General for the Chicago Public Schools in July 2020. CPS OIG is an office of more than 50 members that investigates allegations of fraud, theft, waste and abuse within a \$9b agency of more than 30,000 employees. CPS OIG also has exclusive jurisdiction to investigate allegations of adult-on-student sexual misconduct.

Will has served in offices of inspectors general continuously since July 2010. Previously, Will served for five years as the Inspector General for the Chicago Park District. He also worked as a deputy inspector general at CPS OIG and an Assistant Inspector General at the City of Chicago Office of Inspector General. Will was also an Assistant Attorney General in the Office of the Illinois Attorney General's Special Litigation Bureau and General Counsel of the Chicago Police Department's Office of Professional Standards, a civilian investigative unit that reviewed allegations of police misconduct, including excessive force and police-involved shootings. Will has also practiced law as a litigation attorney at Jenner & Block and served as a judicial clerk to the Hon. Blanche M. Manning in the United States District Court for the Northern District of Illinois.

Will is especially proud of his service to and membership in the AIG and the IG community. In 2016, he was elected president of the Illinois Chapter of the Association of Inspectors General. For the last six years, Will has served as an Instructor at AIG's national Certified Inspector General and Certified Inspector General - Investigator Institutes. Will helped organize AIG's annual Training Conference in October 2018 in Chicago. In November 2019, Will was elected as an AIG Board Member. In November 2021, the Board elected him the AIG Board's First Vice President.

Will graduated Northwestern University with a Bachelor's of Science degree and a Juris Doctor from Columbia Law School in New York. He lives in Chicago with his wife, daughter and his collection of jazz records.
